- *To be interested in their lives and people around them.

Physical development

To develop gross motor skills through; using out door equipment and during P.E sessions where we will be:

- *Exploring different ways of moving with confidence
 - *Follow more than one instruction
 - *To stop on a signal
- * To move with control and coordination
 - *To move in response to music
 - *To match their movements to music
- *Show awareness of space, of themselves and others
- * Recognising the importance of keeping healthy
 - Using a range of small equipment and tools
 - Creative cutting and sticking activities
 - Form most letters correctly



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Personal, Social, Emotional Development

- *To know how to care for themselves
- *To think of ways to keep themselves safe
- * To think about their own and other people's feelings
 - * To be able to play and share with others
 - * To develop their confidence in speaking to other in small groups
 - * To understand that other people have different needs, cultures and beliefs

- *To know number bonds to 5
- *To know and describe 2d and 3d shapes
- *Subitise to 10 and understand parts of a whole amount
- *To understand and use positional language.
- *To solve addition and subtraction problems.
 - *To know odd and even numbers.
 - * To know doubles of numbers to 10.
- To learn about repeating and growing patterns and understand the rules of patterns.

Expressive Arts and Design

- *To recognise colours
- *To explore mixing colours
- *To experiment with malleable materials
 - *To explore different textures
 - *To develop their fixing skills
 - * To make a 3 dimensional structure
 - * To join in with singing rhymes
 - *To explore different musical genres
