

English

During this term, the children will be reading the story Who Let the Gods Out? Using this book, they will be writing; newspaper reports, character descriptions, setting descriptions and more.

The children will also explore an ancient Greek myth Pandora and Prometheus, and write their own narrative story. They will then use this to create a comical set of instructions telling people 'how to write a Greek Myth'.

History

Children will learn and understands some of the things the **Ancient Greeks** gave the world i.e. Olympics, maths for architecture and sculpture and building grand temples like the Parthenon to their gods.

Children will learn about the inventions created and engineers such as Ctesibus and how over time these inventions have been adapted.

Children will learn about Ancient Greek wars and understands the conflict between Athenians and Spartans.
