

### **Democracy**

- \*Class & whole school voting opportunities
- \*Weekly votes for school assembly
- \*Pupils are taught and put in practice how to influence decision making through the democratic process (assemblies/RSE/PHSE)
- \*Pupils are encouraged to become involved in decision making processes (pupil ambassadors/ choosing the 'big question'/pupil voice)

### **Individual Liberty**

- \*Pupils develop self-knowledge, self-esteem & self-confidence through lessons/ well-being sessions/ arts/ leadership opportunities
- \*Pupils are encouraged to take responsibility for their behaviour
- \*Stereotypes are challenged through the curriculum/ aspiration week/ assemblies/ calendar key events
- \*Strong anti-bullying culture

### **Rule of Law**

- \*4 key school rules/ values (be kind, be fair, be safe, be ready to learn)
- \*Pupils are taught to distinguish right from wrong
- \*Pupils are taught to respect the law (assemblies, staff guidance, lessons, posters promoting rules)
- \*Pupils are taught to understand that living under these rules will keep us safe
- \*Local PCSO, Fire service team visit and lead workshops
